

Visitor Rules for TATRATEA TOUR at Tatra Distillery (TATRANSKÁ LIKÉRKA)

1. Purpose

The purpose of these visitor rules is to establish guidelines that must be followed during visits to the production facilities of Tatranská likérka. The goal is to ensure a safe and hygienic tour without disrupting production processes and to maintain the health safety of all products.

2. Scope of Application

These rules apply to all visitors who are not company employees and who enter the production facilities of Tatranská Likérka. They apply to all attendants of the TATRATEA TOUR.

3. Rules for Entering Production Facilities

3.1 Tour Scheduling

- Production process tours are available exclusively by prior arrangement, including the number of people and exact visit time.
- For larger groups (over 10 people), a reservation fee of 50% of the total entry fee must be paid.
- Tours are only available for individuals **over the age of 18**. Minors will not be allowed into the facility.
- Tours are conducted on working days, with the tour time agreed upon in advance.

3.2 Health Safety

- Entry to the production facilities is permitted only to persons over 18 who show no signs of illness.
- Visitors must sign a declaration stating they do not suffer from any infectious disease.

3.3 Assignment of Responsible Staff

- Each tour is accompanied by an employee of Tatranská Likérka who is responsible for its safe conduct. This staff member will ensure that visitors are informed about hygiene principles, workplace safety and behavioral rules in the production areas.

3.4 Protective Clothing

- Each visitor is required to wear protective clothing, including a work coat, head covering, and shoe covers, before entering the production facilities. These protective items are provided by Tatranská Likérka.

3.5 Visitor Briefing

- All visitors without formal training in food production or who have not attended training must be instructed on proper behavior within the production facilities. This briefing includes:
 - The obligation to follow the accompanying staff member's instructions.
 - The requirement to stay with the group and not separate from it.
 - A prohibition against touching raw materials, semi-finished, and finished products without permission.

- A prohibition against handling production equipment without explicit permission from the accompanying staff member.

4. Compliance with Hygiene and Safety Standards

- Each visitor is required to adhere to hygiene standards and workplace safety rules in the production facilities to avoid potential health and safety risks to visitors, employees, and the production itself.

5. Exclusion from the Tour

- Tatranská Likérka reserves the right to refuse entry to visitors who do not respect the rules outlined in this document or who display signs of intoxication or other inappropriate behavior.
